The condition of a property:

When was the apartment last painted? Will the apartment be professionally cleaned? Will the apartment be furnished?

Look at features:

If you want to see a feature in more detail, ask us to focus in on the area or for more images

The view:

If you cannot see the view from the window or the outside space, ask us to show you on the tour or ask for pictures

Local area:

We can give you full knowledge of the local neighbourhood, such as local schools, restaurants, museums etc
